- Exploring display e.g. collections that reflect changes in local landscapes over time
- **Exploring digitalisation** e.g. the landscape of digitised databases and numismatic research
- **Exploring collections management** e.g. museums preserving and interpreting landscapes
- **Exploring education** e.g. informal vs. formal education landscapes

Presentations will typically last 20 minutes and final papers should be sent to the committee by 1<sup>st</sup> June 2016. All abstracts and a selection of full papers will be published in ICOMON e-proceedings.
