## A. How to get to Brescia:

If you come **by plane** you can land at the following airports:

- a. Milano Malpensa ( http://www.malpensa-airport.com )
- b. Milano Linate (http://www.sea-aeroportimilano.it)
- c. Bergamo Orio al Serio (http://www.milanoorio-airport.it)
- d. Villafranca Verona (Valerio Catullo Airport: http://www.aeroportoverona.it)

## From the airports it is possible to reach Brescia by:

- 1. Bus shuttles
- 2. Public transportation systems (train+citybus)
- 3. Cars
- 4. Taxis

## 1) Bus shuttles

They leave at fixed times and booking is requested. <u>From the airports to Brescia the timetable is as follows.</u>

# a) Milano-Malpensa to Brescia

#### From Brescia to the airports

#### a) Brescia to Milano-Malpensa

## c) Brescia to Bergamo-Orio al Serio

## d) Brescia to Villafranca Verona (Catullo airport)

Bus shuttles arrive at the bus station in Via Solferino. It is possible to take a public bus or a taxi to get to the hotel or to the Santa Giulia Museum.

#### 2) Public transportation system (Train+Bus)

From **Milano-Linate** it is possible to reach Milan Railway Station (Milano Stazione Centrale) and to take a train to Brescia ( <u>www.trenitalia.it</u> for information about detailed time-tables and prices)

- a. The connection between the airport and Milano Stazione Centrale is assured by buses which leave every 30 minutes. The journey takes about 20 minutes.
- b. From Milano Stazione Centrale to Brescia: Brescia is on the Turin-Milan-Venice railway line; A train leaves every hour and the journey takes about one hour.

From **Milano-Malpensa** it is possible to reach Milan Railway Station (Milano Stazione Centrale) and take a train to Brescia. (<u>www.trenitalia.it</u> for information about detailed time-tables and prices)

- c. The connection between the airport and Milano Stazione Centrale is assured by buses which leave every 30 minutes. The journey takes about 50 minutes. By taxi, from Malpensa to Milano, it takes 50 minutes.
- d. From Milano Stazione Centrale to Brescia: Brescia is on the Turin-Milan-Venice railway line. There is a train leaving every hour and the journey takes about one hour.

From **Verona-Villafranca** it is possible to reach Verona Railway Station and take a train to Brescia. (www.trenitalia.it for information about detailed time-tables and prices)

- e. For all connections between the airport and Verona, see, http://www.aeroportoverona.it
- f. From Verona to Brescia: Brescia is on the Venice-Milan-Turin railway line. There is a train leaving every hour. The journey takes about one hour.

# 3) By car

- a. From **Milano-Linate** drive towards Milan on the A1 Motorway and then join the A4. Take the exit "Brescia-Centro" and follow the indications towards the City Centre (Centro).
- b. From **Milano-Malpensa** follow the signs to the A8 Motorway to Milan. Then take the A4 towards Venice. Take the exit Brescia-Centro and follow the indications towards the City Centre (Centro).
- c. From **Bergamo-Orio al Serio** drive towards Venice on the A4 Motorway. Take the exit Brescia-Centro and follow the indications towards City Centre (Centro).
- d. From **Villafranca-Verona** drive towards Milan on the A4 Motorway. Take the exit Brescia-Centro and follow the indications towards City Centre (Centro).

## B) How to get to ICOM Conference

The conference will take place in the city centre, i.e. in a restricted traffic area controlled by a network of video cameras (ZTL), and can easily be reached by bus, or by underground (underground station VICTORIA) from the central railway station.
