Meeting objectives: Meeting colleagues, sharing knowledge, making new friends and



	Museums working with audiences and Open Data - Jonathan Whitson-Cloud (Chair of Digital Stangards WG with Intangible Cultural Heritage Working Group) and Professor Maurizio Vivarelli from University of Torino.
	The facilitators will briefly present successful cases working with audiences as well as creating and profiting from Open Data. How these two seemingly different topics can complement each other. Participants are encouraged to bring up their questions and own cases into discussion.
